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## **Chatham Bars Inn opens new sushi restaurant “Maguro”**

Chatham, Mass. (June 22, 2010) – Chatham Bars Inn will open the doors to a new restaurant at the resort this week with the grand opening of “Maguro” sushi restaurant on Wednesday, June 23.

Maguro, which means “tuna” in Japanese, is located in the former Chef’s Table, adjacent to the resort’s opulent main dining room. The menu will feature traditional sushi, as well as innovative hand rolls and hot entrees. Among the more unusual offerings are a Spicy Tuna Hand Roll with Asian pear, radish sprout, pine nut, and spicy sauce; and a Pan seared American Kobe beef served with scallion salad and sweet soy onion dressing. Sake and a selection of traditional Japanese beers will round out the cocktail menu.

The resort has hired esteemed sushi chef Jeffrey Moon as Maguro’s Executive Chef. Originally from Korea, Moon grew up in the New York area and was previously the Executive Chef of Todai Japanese Seafood in New York City. His culinary past also includes roles at New York restaurants TAO, Jean Luc, Madame Tong’s in the Hamptons, City Hall Restaurant and Ruby Foo’s where he was head sushi chef. Moon was trained at the French Culinary Institute in New York.

“Chef Moon brings considerable experience and talent to the table,” said Chatham Bars Inn’s Executive Chef Anthony Cole. “He’s combined his traditional sushi style with some distinctly Cape Cod elements to create an exceptional menu.”

Maguro’s intimate setting seats up to 20 diners and features an open kitchen where the chefs will prepare meals in an interactive setting. Large flatscreen TVs above the kitchen will provide a close-up vantage, so guests don’t miss a step.

“We began offering sushi on our Veranda menu last year and we saw such a tremendous response that we decided to open a full scale restaurant,” said Paul Zuest, Managing Director of Chatham Bars Inn. “Maguro will provide our guests with just one more option for dining at the resort, and the interactive kitchen makes for a unique experience.”

Maguro complements Chatham Bars Inn's extensive restaurant offerings, which include the opulent Main Dining Room, the more casual Tavern, the ocean-side Beach House Grille, and the relaxed Veranda and South Lounge.
